CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That OWEN COOK

of Box 423 - Route 4, Albany, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Soap Creek and reservoir to be constructed under Application No. R-22826, Permit No. R-91 a tributary of Luckiamute River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 18044 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 18, 1947,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.00 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Chamberlain D.L.C. No. 65, Section 5, Township 10 South, Range 4 West, W. M.,

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated from direct flow and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper State officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- 1.2 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Chamberlain D.L.C. No. 65
- 9.6 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Chamberlain D.L.C. No. 65
- 25.4 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Chamberlain D.L.C. No. 65
- 23.4 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Chamberlain D.L.C. No. 65
- 12.2 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Chamberlain D.L.C. No. 65
- 8.0 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Rodgers D.L.C. No. 66
- 3.8 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Rodgers D.L.C. No. 66
- 6.4 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Chamberlain D.L.C. No. 65

Section 5

Township 10 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that described as follows:

Beginning 16.89 chains East of the most Westerly Southwest corner of J. Rodgers D.L.C. 66, thence North 43.75 chains thence East 4.65 chains, thence North 12.0 chains, thence East 17.06 chains, thence South 55.75 chains, thence West 21.7 chains to the point of beginning, being within Section 5, Township 10 South, Range 4 West, W. M. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
