CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JOHN J. FIDLER

of 108 Levens Street, Dallas, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of LaCreole River a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 17706 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 8, 1947,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.027 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Lyle D.L.C. No. 68, Section 32, Township 7 South, Range 5 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- 0.3 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Lyle D.L.C. No. 68
- 1.2 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Lyle D.L.C. No. 68

Section 32

Township 7 South, Range 5 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that described as follows:

Beginning at a point 60 feet North of the Northeast corner of Lot 1 in Block 4 of the original Town (now city) of Dallas, in Polk County, Oregon and running thence North 65.40 feet to the South line of the Muir and McDonald Land; thence North 65° 30' West 94.2 feet to an iron pipe; thence North 78° 10' West 157.5 feet to an iron pipe; thence North 13° 50' West 4.35 chains to the middle of the channel of the LaCreole River; thence up said river North 74° 45' West 6.0 chains; thence South 73° 50' West 3.50 chains; thence South 20° West 3.0 chains; thence South 50° East 3.50 chains; thence South 70° East 3.0 chains; thence South 39° East 2.15 chains to the Northwest corner of A. B. Muir's land; thence East 342 feet; thence North 60 feet to an iron pipe; and thence East on a line parallel with the North line of said Block 4, 176 feet to the place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
