CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is To Certify, That W. H. BOTTEMILLER

of Route 3, Box 873, Albany, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Calapooia River, a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 17601 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 12, 1947.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.04 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, and NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, As projected within L. S. Helm D.L.C. No. 64, Section 35, Township 11 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall be still further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 1.04 c.f.s.

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

27.6 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Lawrence S. Helm D.L.C. No. 64
24.4 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Lawrence S. Helm D.L.C. No. 64
7.8 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Lawrence S. Helm D.L.C. No. 64
10.6 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Lawrence S. Helm D.L.C. No. 64

9.7 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within Lawrence S. Helm D.L.C. No. 64

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that described as follows:

Beginning at the SE corner of the Lawrence S. Helm D.L.C. No. 64, T. 11 S., R. 4 W., W. M., thence North 21.15 chains, thence North 89° West 75.4 chains, thence South 20.07 chains, thence South 88° East 75.4 chains; also beginning at the NE corner of Thomas I. Anderson D.L.C. No. 75 in T. 11 S., R. 4 W., W. M., running South 34 rods, thence Northeasterly along county road 60 rods to the North line of said claim, thence East to the point of beginning; also Lot 3, Sec. 35, T. 11 S., R. 4 W., W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
