CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That DONALD R. GIBBS

of 624 W. Finlay, Roseburg, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of South Umpqua River a tributary of Pacific Ocean for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 17838 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 30, 1947.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.009 cubic foot per second.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within J. Huntley D.L.C. No. 56, Section 13, Township 27 South, Range 6 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

0.5 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within J. E. Huntley D.L.C. No. 56
 0.25 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within J. E. Huntley D.L.C. No. 56
 Section 13
 Township 27 South, Range 6 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that described as follows: Beginning at a $\frac{1}{2}$ " iron pipe which is 25 ft. North of North boundary line of the present Roseburg High School tract, said beginning point being South 88° 52' West 402.3 ft. and North 0° 15' West 25.0 feet from the most northerly NE corner of said High School tract, said NE corner being described in County Clerks Deed Records in Vol. 86, page 622, as being North 0° 15' West 1200.00 feet and West 5.0 ft. from the SW corner of Lot 5, Block E, laurelwood Addition to Roseburg, Oregon; thence running parallel to and 25.0 feet North of the North line of said school tract, South 88° 52' West 120.5 ft. to a $\frac{1}{2}$ " iron pipe thence North 0° 15' West 371.12 feet to a point on the left bank of the South Umpqua River; thence following river meanderings upstream along said left bank South 86° 42' East 121.27 feet to a 2" iron pipe; thence South 6° 15' East 355.4 feet to the place of beginning containing one acre, more or less, all the above being in the Jermiah Huntley Donation Land Claim No. 56, T. 27 S., R. 6 W., W. M., Douglas County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
