CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That DAVID E. WILSON

, State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Little Rock Creek

a tributary of W. Fork of Illinois River

for the purpose of

irrigation and domestic use for one family under Permit No. 17966 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters 17966 has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 23, 1947.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.11 cubic foot per second, being 0.10 c.f.s. for irrigation and 0.01 c.f.s. for domestic use.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the CE NET. Section 27, Township 40 South, Range ? West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other of one cubic foot per second right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fiftieth per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated throughout the irrigation season from April 1st to November 1st of each year, and shall be still further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 0.11 c.f.s.

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows: 4.0 acres in the SW NW

1.0 acres in the NW SW Section 26

Township 40 South, Range 9 West, W. M. Land on which water is to be used is a part of that described as follows: Beginning at the initial point, which lies 2326 ft. South of and 1248 ft. East of the NW corner of Sec. 26. T. 40 S., R. 9 W., W. M., in Josephine County, Oregon, which is the true point of beginning this description, running thence South 25° 04° East 410 ft. more or less to the intersection of the South line of the NW of Sec. 26, T. 40 S. R. 9 W., and the Westerly right-of-way line of the old stage road to Cresent City, Calif.; thence Southwesterly along the Westerly right-of-way line of said road to it's intersection with the South line of the Nw $_{1}^{+}$ of the Sw $_{2}^{+}$ of said section and range; thence west along said South line to the Sw corner of Nw $_{4}^{+}$ of the SW¹, said section, township and range to the west line of said Sec. 26; thence North along said West line of Sec. 26, to the NW corner of Sec. 26; thence South 89° 40' East along the North line of said Sec. 26 to a point which lies North 3° 11' East from the point of beginning; thence South 3° 11' West 2047.9 feet to the point of beginning, containing 110.80 acres, were or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
