CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That T. O. GOODMAN,

of P. O. Box 77, Pendleton, State of Oregon, has a right to the use of
the waters of EAST BRANCH OF MUD CREEK, a tributary of the Walla Walla
River, in Umatilla County, Oregon,

for the purpose of irrigation, (during the irrigation season)

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of
Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem,
in the Order Record of the Board of Control of the State of Oregon, in Volume 1, at
page 113 ; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1885 for
the irrigation of ten acres and from 1906 for the irrigation of ten acres of
land;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the
purpose aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said pur-
pose, and shall not exceed 0.13 cubic feet per second as of date 1885 and 0.13
cubic feet per second as of date 1906;

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water
hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water
is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

Ten (10) acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$; ten (10) acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$; Sec. 22, Tp.
6 N. R. 35 E., W. M., in Umatilla County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the
lands or place of use herein described.
