**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That** A. H. and ANNA D. BLENZ

of Route 1, Brownsville, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Calapooya River a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 21199 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 19, 1952,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.196 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within James R. Templeton D.L.C. No. 52, Section 11, Township 14 South, Range 2 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

12.5 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$   
0.8 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$   
2.4 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$

All as projected within James R. Templeton D.L.C. No. 52  
Section 11  
Township 14 South, Range 2 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that described as follows:

Beginning at a point on Sweet Home-Halsey Highway, 26 chains East and 11 chains North of the SW corner of J. R. Templeton D.L.C. No. 52, thence Northwesterly along said Highway 12 chains, thence North 20 chains to Calapooya River, thence Southeasterly along said River 10 chains thence South to place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
