## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## This Is to Certify, That D. R. CAIRNES

of Route 1. Brownsville , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Calapooya River

a tributary of Willamette River

for the purpose of

irrigetion under Permit No. 21566 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the law of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from June 30. 1952.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.056 cubic foot per second.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the 'SW\frac{1}{4}. as projected within Josiah Osborne D.L.C. No. 53. Section 12. Township 14 South, Range 2 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.0 acres in the Nw. Sw., as projected within Josiah Osborne D.L.C. No. 53
2.5 acres in the Sw. Sw., as projected within Josiah Osborne D.L.C. No. 53
Section 12
Township 14 South, Range 2 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that described as follows:

That part of the NW $^{\downarrow}_{\tau}$  SW $^{\downarrow}_{\tau}$  lying westerly of the C<sub>a</sub>lapooya River, and that part of the SW $^{\downarrow}_{\tau}$  SW $^{\downarrow}_{\tau}$  lying between the Calapooya River and the Halsey-Sweet Home Highway.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
