CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That I. G. NAYLOR

of Route 1, Box 104, Murphy, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Williams Creek (William Creek Slough) a tributary of Applegate River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 23384 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 19, 1955,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.03 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 1, Township 38 South, Range 5 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

2.0 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
 Section 1

Township 38 South, Range 5 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that described as follows:

Beginning at a corner in Williams Creek 265 feet East from the NW corner of the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 1, T. 38 S., R. 5 W., W. M., Josephine County, Oregon and running thence East along the North line of the S $\frac{1}{2}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said section a distance of 425 feet to the Southerly side of the County Road; thence follow the Southerly or Southwesterly side of the County Road South 46° 53' East 375 feet; to the Northwesterly corner of a church lot with a frontage of 44 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet on said road and a depth of 71 feet back therefrom; thence South 57° East 563 feet; thence at right angle to said County Road South 33° West 700 feet to Williams Creek; thence follow said Williams Creek downstream North 34° 29' West 1395 feet to the place of beginning, containing 12.6 acres, more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
