**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That**     EVERETT C. SWEARINGEN

of     Route 2, Springfield     , State of     Oregon     , has made proof  
to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of  
Gilkey Creek and Camp Creek  
a tributary of     McKenzie River     for the purpose of  
irrigation and supplemental irrigation  
under Permit No.     17046     of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters  
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby  
confirmed dates from     June 11, 1946,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes  
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed  
0.45 cubic foot per second, 0.04 c.f.s. from Gilkey Creek and 0.41 c.f.s. from  
Camp Creek,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.  
The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within James Worth D.L.C.  
No. 39, on Gilkey Creek, and the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within J. Stevenson  
D.L.C. No. 67, on Camp Creek, all in Section 24, Township 17 South, Range 2  
West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other  
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second  
per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited  
to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated  
during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is  
appurtenant, is as follows:

GILKEY CREEK

3.5 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within James Worth D.L.C. No. 39

CAMP CREEK

1.6 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within J. Stevenson D.L.C. No. 67  
3.5 acres (supplemental) in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within James Worth, D.L.C. No. 39  
6.6 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within J. Stevenson D.L.C. No. 67  
16.8 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within J. Stevenson D.L.C. No. 67  
7.4 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ , as projected within J. Stevenson D.L.C. No. 67  
0.1 acres in Lot 2 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SW $\frac{1}{4}$ ), as projected within J. Stevenson D.L.C. No. 67  
Section 24  
Township 17 South, Range 2 West, W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of  
use herein described.
