the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, made and entered

of record in the Record of Proceedings of said Board, at Salem, in Volume 1

at page 280, on the 9th day of Larch, 1918; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 15,1912 that the amount of

water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not

exceed 0.10 cubic feet per second.

A description of the lands under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: The NEINEI of Section 8, and the SEISEI of Section 5, Township 41 South, Range 17 West of Willamette Meridian, in Curry County, Oregon.

(NOTE: This certificate is issued to correct and supercede that certain certificate issued to the above parties Mar: .26, 1918, and recorded in Vol 3, at page 1956 of State Record of Water Right Certificates, and Vol. 1 at page 13 of Record of Water Right Certificates of Curry County, the right under said former certificate being erroneously described as being inthe SW2SW2 of Sec. 4, T. 41 S., R. 13 W., whereas said right is in fact situated as above described in this certificate

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.
