## WATER RIGHT CERTIFICATE

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, CROOK Oregon for in the Order Record of the ETATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 1, at ; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1901;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed .2 cubic feet per second.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water 10 acres in the Southwest quarter of is put to beneficial use, is as follows: Southeast quarter of Section Six, Township Sixteen South, Range Eleven East of Willamette Meridian, in Deschutes County, Oregon.
