CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(For Rights which have been confirmed by the Courts)

This is to Certify, That H. M. BUTLER, c/o H.H.DeArmond of Bend State of Oregon has a right to the use of the waters of Squaw Creek, a tributary of the Deschutes River

for the purposes of irrigation and domestic use (irrigation during the irrigation season)

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for CROOK County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE WATER BOARD of the State of Oregon, in Volume 1, at page 120 ; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from 1901;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purpose, and shall not exceed .2 cubic feet per second.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 10 acres in the Southwest quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Six, Township Sixteen South, Range Eleven East of Willamette Meridian, in Deschutes County, Oregon.

(NOTE: This certificate is issued to correct and supercede that certain certificate issued to Edward White on November 29, 1911, and recorded in Vol 1, at Page 309 of State Record of Water Right Certificates, and at Water Right record 1, page 121, Water right certificates for Crook County, the right under said former certificate being erroneously described as being in the NE 1/4 Section 6, T. 16 S., R. 11 E. W. M., whereas said right is in fact situated as above described in this certificate.)

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
