CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That STATE OF OREGON, BOARD OF FORESTRY

of 2600 State Street, Salem, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed spring a tributary of John Day River for the purpose of domestic, for one family and crew of 5 men, including irrigation of not to exceed $\frac{1}{2}$ acre, under Permit No. 18972 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 8, 1949,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 23, Township 13 South, Range 31 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 23
Township 13 South, Range 31 East, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that described as follows:
Beginning at a point 945.0 feet North and 660.0 feet West of the SW corner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 23, T. 13 S., R. 31 E., W. M.; thence North 375.0 feet; thence West along the North line of said $\frac{1}{4}$ section 174.24 feet; thence South 375.0 feet; thence East 174.24 feet to the point of beginning, all in Sec. 23, T. 13 S., R. 31 E., W. M., situated and being in the County of Grant and State of Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
