CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That GUS E. and LOLA PATTERSON

of Box 1145, Eugene, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream a tributary of Alsea River for the purpose of domestic use for one family, including the irrigation of not to exceed $\frac{1}{2}$ acre under Permit No. 19457 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 15, 1950.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 35, Township 13 South, Range 10 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _____ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 35
Township 13 South, Range 10 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that described as follows:

Beginning at a point 1941.35 feet E. and 968.64 feet S. of the NW corner, Sec. 35, T. 13 S., R. 10 W., W. M., running thence S. 53° 02' E. 67.4 feet; thence S. 34° 07' W. 67.9 feet; thence S. 25° 07' W. 458.0 feet, more or less to meander line of Alsea River; thence N. 73° 00' W. along meander line of Alsea River 427.0 feet, more or less to unnamed creek; thence Northeasterly along center of unnamed creek to place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
