CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is To Certify, That

RALPH E. ALVORD

of 819 Failing Bldg., Portland , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Tualatin River

a tributary of Willamette River for the purpose of

irrigation

under Permit No. 14260 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 25, 1940,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.32 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW NW & NW SW Section 10, Township 2 South Range 2 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second peracre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

M., Washington County, Oregon. Running thence N. 81° 14' W. along the Southerly line of RAINBOW ENDS 84.0 feet to an iron; thence S. 17° 12' W. 1379.2 feet to an iron; thence continuing S. 17° 12' W. 117 feet, more or less, to the center of the Tualatin River; thence downstream following the main channel of the Tualatin River approximately 6200 feet to the SE corner of said Lot 3; thence N. 72° 48' W. 1519.6 feet to the place of beginning.
