Grandview Oregon . Stute of , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, of a right to the use of the Deschutes River Metolius River , a tributary of , for the purpose of the irrigation of 10 acres of land Permit No. 1755 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, made and entered of record in the Record of Proceedings of said Board, at Salem, in Volume at page 301 , on the 20th day of November, 1918; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dutes from September 11,1913: that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not

exceed 0.125 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The use hereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper State Officer A description of the lands under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 5.4 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Thirty-four and 4.6 acres in the Southwest quarter of Southwest quarter of Section Thirty-five, Township Ten South, Range Ten East of Willamette Meridian, in Jefferson County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.
