CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ERNEST A. PAULSEN and JOHN SPRIK
P. O. Box 748, Coquille, and , State of Oregon , has made proof
of Bandon , to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of
Crooked Creek a tributary of Pacific Ocean for the purpose of
irrigation under Permit No. 16901 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from April 15, 1946,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
0.125 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 8, Township 29 South, Range
14 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-tenth of one cubic foot per second
per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited
to a diversion of not to exceed 0.75 acre-foot for each acre irrigated in any
30-day period and shall still further be limited to a diversion of not to exceed
6 acre-feet per acre during the irrigation season of each year, and shall be
still further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 0.125 c.f.s.,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is
appurtenant, is as follows:

3.01 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
0.86 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 8
Township 29 South, Range 14 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that described as follows:

A parcel of land situated in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 8, T. 29 S., R. 14 W.,
W. M., Coos County, Oregon.
Beginning at the NE corner of the said NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, thence West 100.0 feet, South
14° 28' W. 800.4 feet, East 300.0 feet, thence North 775.0 feet to beginning.
Also the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 8.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That MARVIN SPORES

of Route 1, Springfield, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Mohawk River, a tributary of McKenzie River, for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 17013 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 20, 1946,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.07 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 1 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$) & SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within W. Simmons D.L.C. No. 69, Section 17, and Lot 3 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$), Section 16, all in Township 17 South, Range 2 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- 0.1 acres in Lot 5 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$)
Section 9
- 0.8 acres in Lot 3 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$)
- 0.2 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within J. Scott D.L.C. No. 72
Section 16
- 1.6 acres in Lot 1 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$)
- 3.2 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, as projected within W. Simmons D.L.C. No. 69
Section 17
Township 17 South, Range 2 West, W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
