CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JULIA G. HOWARD

of Box 21, Gaylord, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed spring a tributary of South Fork of Coquille River for the purpose of domestic use for one family under Permit No. 18444 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 3, 1948,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 23, Township 30 South, Range 12 West, W. K.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Lot 1 (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$)
 Section 23

Township 30 South, Range 12 West, W. K.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that described as follows:
 Beginning 455 feet South of the NW corner of Lot 1, Sec. 23, T. 30 S., R. 12 W., W. K.; thence South along the West line of said Sec. 23 to the North bank of the South Fork of the Coquille River; thence East along the North bank of South Fork of said River to the mouth of Yellow Creek; thence North along the West bank of Yellow Creek to a point where a small brook intersects Yellow Creek from the Northwest being 160 feet, West of the Falls of Yellow Creek more or less; thence Northwest 160 feet along said brook; thence West along south line of said highway to beginning, containing four acres.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
