of Nyssa and Owyhee, respectively, State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Owyhee River a tributary of Snake River , for the purpose of the irrigation of 149 acres of land Permit No. 1977 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, made and entered of record in the Record of Proceedings of said Board, at Sulem, in Volume November, 1918 day of , on the 20th ; that the priority of at page March 19, 1914 the right hereby confirmed dates from that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not

exceed 1.86 cubic feet per second, or its equivalent in case of rotation. The use mereunder shall conform to any reasonable rotation system ordered by the proper State Officer. A description of the lands under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 21 acres in the Southwest quarter of Southwest quarter; 27 acres in the Southwest cuarter of Southeast quarter of Northwest quarter and 15 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northwest quarter of Section Five and 15 acres in the Northeast quarter of Northeast quarter of Section Six, Township Twenty-one South, Range Forty-six, All East of Willamette Meridian, in Malheur County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water aforesuid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.
