Butte Falls , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Rancheria Creek and Camp Creek , a tributary of Big Butte and North Fork , for the purpose of the irrigation of 30 acres of land, and domestic use Permit No. 2334 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, made and entered of record in the Record of Proceedings of said Board, at Salem, in Volume 1 at page on the 20th day of November, 1918 the right hereby confirmed dates from

the right hereby confirmed dates from November 11,1914; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not

exceed 0.48 cubic feet per second.

A description of the lands under such right, and to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows: 10 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southeast quarter; 5 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southeast quarter of Section Twenty-four, Township Thirty-four South, Range Three? 4 acres in Lot 3; 2 acres in Lot 4; 3 acres in the Northeast quarter of Southwest quarter and 6 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southwest quarter and 6 acres in the Southeast quarter of Southwest quarter of Southwest quarter four South, Range Four, All East of Willamette Meridian, in Jackson County, Oregon.

The use for irrigation purposes hereunder shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second for each acre irrigated, or its equivalent in case of rotation; balance for domestic use. The use for irrigation purposes shall conform to any reasonable frequency system ordered by the proper State Officer.

The right to the use of the water aloresaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.

Rights to the use of water for power purposes are limited to a period of forty years from the date of priority of the right, as herein set forth, subject to a preference right of renewal under the laws existing at the date of the expiration of the right for power purposes, as hereby confirmed and limited.
