ofP. O. Box 232, Mehama State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Evans Creek

a tributary ofLittle North Fork (North fork Santiam River)

for the purpose of

domestic use for 2 families and power (not electrical)

under Permit No. 18109 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 26, 1947, for 0.02 c.f.s. and November 20, 1947,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.77 cubic foot per second, being 0.02 c.f.s. for domestic and 2.75 c.f.s. for power.

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Win New Section 32, Township 8 South, Range 4 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to _ _ _ _ _ _ _ of one cubic foot per second per acre,

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

> SW# NW# Section 32 Township 8 South, Range 4 East, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that described as follows: Beginning at the NW corner of the SW! NW#, Sec. 32, T. 8 S., A. 4 E., W. M., in Marion County, Oregon; thence running South 864 feet to the north line of the county road; thence following the north line of said road in a southeasterly direction to a point 82 feet East of the West line of said Sec. 32; thence North 275 feet to the center of Evans Creek; thence following the center of said Lvans Creek up stream to a point 200 feet East and 185 feet South of the point of beginning; thence North 185 feet; thence West 200 feet to the point of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
