CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That R. F. SCHMIDT

of 106 S. Water Street, Silverton, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed spring a tributary of Silver Creek, a tributary of Pudding River for the purpose of irrigation and domestic under Permit No. 18880 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 10, 1949,

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 2, Township 7 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1 house domestic and $\frac{1}{2}$ acre irrigation
SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 2
NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 11

Township 7 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that described as follows:

Commencing at the most westerly NW corner of the D.L.C. of Buford Smith and wife in T. 7 S., R. 1 W., W. M.; thence North 44° East 1.48 chains; thence North 43° 15' West 14.08 chains; thence South 30° West 8.0 chains to the middle of County Road leading from Silverton to Silver Creek Falls; thence S. 36° 48' East along the center of said road 20.30 chains to a point in the West boundary line of aforesaid D.L.C.; thence N. along the line of Hicks Bros. land 11.6 chains to the beg. containing 13.65 acres of land,
Save and except therefrom land sold from the above described tract to Frank Sawyerber.
The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
