**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is To Certify, That** ROY A. JACOBSON AND NEIL HARDING

of Box 495, Coos Bay, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed creek a tributary of Mill Creek for the purpose of domestic and irrigation (domestic for two families) under Permit No. 18251 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 10, 1948

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.04 cubic foot per second, being 0.02 cubic foot per second for domestic and 0.02 cubic foot per second for irrigation

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NW $\frac{1}{4}$ , As projected within Nelson Northrup DIC No. 41, Section 34, Township 25 South, Range 13 West, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to One-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Domestic and 1.0 acre in Lot 7  
Domestic and 0.55 acre in Lot 8  
Section 34  
Township 25 South, Range 13 West, W.M.

Description of Harding Lands. Beginning at a point 615 feet South and 305 feet East of the Northwest corner of Lot 7 of Section 34, Township 25 South, Range 13 West of Willamette Meridian, in Coos County, Oregon; thence running East 350 feet; thence South 498 feet to the South line of said Lot 7; thence West along the lot line 350 feet; thence North 498.4 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning, containing four acres of land, more or less, located in Lot 7 of Section 34, Township 25 South, Range 13 West of Willamette Meridian, Coos County, Oregon.

Description of Jacobson Lands. Beginning at an iron pipe on the Lot line 615 feet South from the Northwest corner of Lot 7 of Section 34, Township 25 South, Range 13 West of Willamette Meridian, Coos County, Oregon; thence running West 435.6 feet thence South 100.0 feet; thence South 86° 43' East 450.0 feet, more or less, to the County road, thence along said road, North 41° 08' East 167.1 feet, to a point East of the Point of beginning, thence West 125.3 feet, more or less, to the place of beginning, containing 1.35 acres, of land, more or less, located in Lot 8 of said Section 34, Township 25 South, Range 13 West of Willamette Meridian, Coos County, Oregon.

*The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.*
