CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That RITTER HOT SPRINGS

of Ritter, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Ritter Hot Springs a tributary of Middle Fork of the John Day River for the purpose of domestic, hot mineral baths and irrigation under Permit No. 21828 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 29, 1953

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW¹/₄ NW¹/₄, Section 8, Township 8 South, Range 30 East, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-fortieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 5 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall be still further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 0.02 cubic foot per second.

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Bath units, domestic and 1.0 acre in the NW¹/₄ NW¹/₄
 domestic SW¹/₄ NW¹/₄
 Section 8
 Township 8 South, Range 30 East, W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Legally is Township 8 South, Range 30 East, Section 8, known as the Ritter Hot Springs at Ritter, Grant County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
