at page 301 , on the 20th day of November, 1918 ; that the priority of
the right hereby confirmed dates from August 3, 1915; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not
exceed 1.77 cubic feet per second.
A description of the lands under such right, and to which the water hereby
