aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said pur	poses, and shall not exceed

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the $SE_4^{\frac{1}{4}}$ $NE_4^{\frac{1}{4}}$, Section 34, Township 1 North, Range 4 West, Well.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one—eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows: 5.00 acres in the $SE_{\frac{1}{4}}$ $NE_{\frac{1}{4}}$

Section 35
Township 1 North, Range 4 West, W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows: Beginning at a point 20.10 chains west from a post on the east line of the DIC of Ammon Knighton in Section 35, T. 1 N., R. 4 W., W.M., \$1.95 chains from the southeast corner of said claim, and from this beginning point running thence N. 0 degrees, \$15 minutes E. 680 feet, then S. 88 degrees, \$11 minutes, W. 480 feet, then N. 0 degrees, \$15 minutes E. 202.5 feet, then N. 89 degrees, \$55 minutes W. 1250.1 feet, then S. 6 degrees, 3 minutes, E. 246.2 feet, then N. 88 degrees, \$11 minutes E. 505.9 feet, then N. 1 degree, 26 minutes W. 38 feet, then N. 88 degrees, \$11 minutes E. 110 feet, then S. 1 degree, 26 minutes E. 28 feet, then N. 88 degrees \$11 minutes E. 556 feet.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
