CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CHAS. H. HOYT & GLADYS C. HOYT

of 103 Cherry Street, Silverton, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Fall River a tributary of _____ for the purpose of domestic for one family under Permit No. 19743 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 26, 1950

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 31, Township 20 South, Range 10 East, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 31
Township 20 South, Range 10 East, W.M.

Beginning at a point on the East and West center line through the center of Section 31, T. 20 S., R. 10 E., of the W.M., which said point is three inches North of an 8" blazed jackpine and is South 89° 36' 10" east from the quarter section corner on the west side of Section 31, a distance of 1109 feet; and running thence south 89° 36' 10" East along the said east and west center line 994 feet to the center of Fall River; thence southwesterly up the center of Fall River to a point in the center of the river, which point bears south 48° 13' west 735.65 feet from the first point; thence north 41° 40' 10" west, 670 feet to the point of beginning, containing about 5.5 acres, more or less.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
