of Route #1, Box 9, Yamhill, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Turner Creek and res. to be constructed under App. No. R-25390, Per. No. R-1197 a tributary of Yamhill River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 19292 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 8, 1950 for 0.094 cubic foot per second and June 28, 1950 for 0.066 cubic foot per second; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.16 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4, As projected within Perkins DLC 55, Township 2 South, Range 4 West, W.M.
