Township 38 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other

per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That PAUL C. LEE

of Box 1, Applegate, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Humbug Creek a tributary of Big Applegate River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 22380 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from April 29, 1953.

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.41 cubic foot per second,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the ^{SE}SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 14, and the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 23, Township 38 South, Range 4 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eighth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,
