CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That L. F. EMMOTT
of c/o Mrs. C. E. Riggs, Box 5116, Aloha, Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream a tributary of Tillamook Bay for the purpose of domestic for one family, including 1/2 acre domestic gardens or lawns (irrigation) under Permit No. 17161 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 17, 1946

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 7 (NE 1/4 SW 1/4), Section 22, Township 1 North, Range 10 West, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

Lot 7 (NE 1/4 SW 1/4)
Section 22
Township 1 North, Range 10 West, W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is a part of that described as follows:

Commencing at a stake 104 feet NE from Indian Adams corner, running 209 feet Southeasterly thence 104 feet Northeasterly; thence 159 feet Northwesterly; thence Southwesterly 30 feet; thence Northwesterly 50 feet; thence 74 feet to place of beginning less small tract sold to Luther A. Elliff and recorded in Deed Book 88 at page 509 in the office of the County Clerk of Tillamook County, Oregon, September 21, 1944; all situated in Lot 7 on the Miami River in Section 22, T. 1 N., R. 10 W., W.M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
