under Permit No. 17277 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from September 16, 1946

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation. measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SWA NEW, Section 29, Township 1 South, Range 1 East, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.0 acre in the SW¹/₄ NE¹/₄
Section 29
Township 1 South, Range 1 East, W.M.

All that part of Tax Lot 4, Section 29, Township 1 South, Range 1 East of the Willamette Meridian, in the County of Multnomah and State of Oregon, described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the Southerly line of S.W. Taylor's Ferry Road, as now established 150 feet Easterly from the Northeasterly corner of that certain tract of land conveyed to S.W. Graham by deed recorded August 25, 1916 in Deed Book 722, page 15; thence South 71° 17° West along the said Southerly line of S.W. Taylor's Ferry Road, 150 feet to the Northeasterly corner of the said Graham tract; thence South 11° 52° East, along the Easterly line of the said Graham tract, 211.27 feet to the Southeasterly corner thereof; thence South 68° 32° West, along the Southerly line of the said Graham tract, 217.01 feet to the Southwesterly corner thereof; thence South 61° 05° East along the Northeasterly line of that certain tract of land conveyed to Eva B. Clark, by deed recorded December 23, 1931 in P. S. Deed Book 151, page 21.7, 551.89 feet to the re-entrant corner of that certain tract of land conveyed to Portland Trust and Savings Bank by deed recorded February 27, 1936 in P.S. Deed Book 327, page 117, thence North 71° 21° East along the Northerly line of the said Portland Trust and Savings Bank tract, 50 feet to a point; thence Northwesterly to the point of beginning;

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
