**CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT**

**This Is to Certify, That MILLER MILL & MFG. COMPANY**

of Joseph \_\_\_\_\_, State of Oregon \_\_\_\_\_, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Wallowa River a tributary of Grande Ronde River for the purpose of to maintain log pond under Permit No. 18550 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 14, 1948

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 2.0 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 30, Township 2 South, Range 45 East, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

SW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$   
Section 30  
Township 2 South, Range 45 East, W.M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of the property described as follows:

Beginning at a point on the north bank of the Wallowa River where the quarter section line between the SW $\frac{1}{4}$  and the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 30, T 2 S., R 45 E., W.M., crosses said river; running thence North and along said quarter section line 284 feet and 2 inches to the south line of the right of way of the O. W. R. R. & N. Company; thence Northeasterly along said south line of the said right of way 904 feet 3 inches; thence South 648 feet 7 inches to the right of way line of the Hurricane Creek State Highway; thence southwest on and along the West right of way line of the Hurricane Creek State Highway a distance of 74 feet 6 inches to the north bank of the Wallowa River; thence westerly and along the north bank of said Wallowa River to the point of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
