## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## This Is to Certify, That v. s. FOREST SERVICE

c/O Forest Supervisor, Deschutes National of Forest, Bend , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed spring which sinks into ground a tributary of for the purpose of

under Permit No. 18848 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 18, 1949

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0-40 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the  $SE_4^2$   $NW_4^2$   $NE_2^2$ , Section 27, Township 13 South, Range 8 East, W.M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ---- of one cubic foot per second per acre,

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
