## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That WILLIAM MORTON ELDER and JEANSTTE ELDER

of Pendleton

, has a right to the use of

the waters of McKay Creek, a tributary of Umatilla River

for the purpose of the irrigation of 50 acres of land, domestic and stock use

and that said right has been confirmed by decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County, and the said decree entered of record at Salem, in the Order Record of the STATE ENGINEER, in Volume 15, at page 454; that the priority of the right thereby confirmed dates from January 1904

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.63 cubic foot per second, subject to the provisions of paragraph 33 of said decree.

A description of the lands irrigated under such right, and to which the water is appurtenant (or, if for other purposes, the place where such water is put to beneficial use), is as follows:

20.0 acres in the NN to NN to 10.0 acres in the SN to NN to 10.0 acres in the SE to NN to 20.0 acres in Umatilla County, Oregon

Note: This certificate is issued pursuant to a Decree of the Circuit Court of the State of Oregon for Umatilla County in Suit for Equity No. 11,703, entered on September 20, 1956, by the Honorable William W. Wells, Circuit Judge, to correct and supersede that certain water right certificate heretofore issued in the name of Marion Jack of Pendleton, Oregon, and recorded in State Record of Water Right Certificates, Vol. 3, page 2560, so as to properly describe the lands as being located in Section 34, Township 2 North, Range 32 East, W. M.

And said right shall be subject to all other conditions and limitations contained in said decree.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
