mundei Permit No. 21913 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 11, 1950

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 1.3 cubic feet per second, being O.433 c.f.s. from Lange Creek and O.867 c.f.s. from Classic Lake Creek,

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the WW4SW4, Section 16 on Classic Lake Creck, and NW4SE4, Section 2 on Lange Creek, Township 3 North, Range 10 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to \_\_\_\_\_ of one cubic foot per second per acre,
