## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

## This Is to Certify, That

CLARENCE H. CASSEL

of Nyssa , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Snake River a tributary of Columbia River for the purpose of supplemental irrigation and irrigation under Permit No. 16515 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the ight hereby confirmed dates from

August 27, 1945

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.444 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the Lot 1 (NE 1NW 1), Section 31, Township 20 South, Range 47 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-sixtieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season, from April 1, to October 15 of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

supplementary irrigation of 20.0 acres in the S 3/4 NW1NW1 primary irrigation of 6.4 acres in the S 3/4 Lot 1 (NE NW2)

Section 31

Township 20 South, Range 47 East, W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
