under Permit No. 20725 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 10, 1951

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.37 cubic foot per second, being 0.28 cfs from Davis Creek and 0.09 cfs from Pond Branch

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the  $SE\frac{1}{4}NW\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 13,  $SE\frac{1}{4}NE\frac{1}{4}$  &  $NE\frac{1}{4}SE\frac{1}{4}$ , Section 14, Township 30 South, Range 15 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- 6.7 acres in the  $NE\frac{1}{4}NE\frac{1}{4}$
- 4.5 acres in the  $SE\frac{1}{4}NE\frac{1}{4}$
- Section 14
- 10.0 acres in the  $SW\frac{1}{4}NW\frac{1}{4}$
- 7.3 acres in the  $SE\frac{1}{4}NW\frac{1}{4}$
- 0.7 acres in the  $NE\frac{1}{4}SW\frac{1}{4}$

M. Also the  $W\frac{1}{2}NW\frac{1}{4}$ , all the  $SE\frac{1}{4}NW\frac{1}{4}$  lying west of the State Highway of Sec. 13, T 30 S., R 15 W., W. M.

Also beginning 204.9 feet east of the SW corner of the said  $SE\frac{1}{4}NW\frac{1}{4}$  of said section 13; thence S. 63° 30' E. 103.6 feet; thence N 83° 15' E. 219.1 feet; thence S. 66° 37' E. 466.8 feet to the west boundary of the State Highway; thence along said west boundary northerly to a point east of beginning; thence west to beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
