CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That CHAS. PORTER

of Cloverdale, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Smith Creek a tributary of Big Nestucca River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 20843 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from November 5, 1951

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.15 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 22, Township 4 South, Range 10 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.8 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 15
10.1 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
Section 22
Township 4 South, Range 10 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Beginning at the Northeast corner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 22, Township 4 South, Range 10 West of the Willamette Meridian, thence South 9 $\frac{1}{4}$ chains, thence West 14 chains thence North 17 chains, thence East 2 chains, thence southeasterly to a point 7 chains West of the point of beginning thence East to place of beginning, all in Sections 15 and 22, Township 4 South, Range 10 West of the Willamette Meridian.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
