CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That LELAND S. JOHNS ⁹⁷⁴¹⁰
of Azalea, State of Oregon, has made proof
to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of
Clear Creek
a tributary of Cow Creek for the purpose of
supplemental irrigation
under Permit No. 21773 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from September 11, 1952

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes
aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed
0.53 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.
The point of diversion is located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 11, Township 32 South, Range 5
West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other
right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ~~one-seventieth~~ of one cubic foot per second
per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited
to a diversion of not to exceed 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated
during the irrigation season of each year, provided further that the amount of
water allowed herein, together with the amount secured under any other right
existing for the same lands shall not exceed the limitations allowed herein,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is
appurtenant, is as follows:

10 acres in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
26 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$
1 acre in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$

Section 11
Township 32 South, Range 5 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Commencing at the S.E. corner of Sec. 11, T. 32 S., R. 5 W., W. M. and running West
25 rods, thence North 5.5 rods to the true point of beginning of this description;
thence running North 155.5 rods to the center line of said Sec. 11; thence West along
said center line 215 rods to the West line of the E $\frac{1}{2}$ of the W $\frac{1}{2}$ of said Sec. 11; thence
South, along said line, 80 rods; thence East 80 rods to the center line of said Sec.
11; thence South, along said line 65.7 rods; thence East 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ rods to the Westerly line
of the Old Pacific Highway; thence South 40° West, along said Highway line 150 ft.,
more or less to a point 5.5 rods North of the South line of said Sec. 11; thence East
along said line, 115 rods to the true point of beginning. Less and excepting Road
and Highway rights of way.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of
use herein described.
