This Is to Certify, That C. W. KUNZ
 of Route 2, Dayton, State of Oregon, has made proof
 to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to store the waters of
 Martin Creek, a tributary of Yamhill River to be appropriated under Application
 No. 23835, Permit No. 19179

for the purposes of
 irrigation

under Reservoir Permit No. R-1008 of the State Engineer, and that said right to store said
 waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right
 hereby confirmed dates from June 9, 1949

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes afore-
 said, shall not exceed 45 acre-feet.
