under Permit No. 10028 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 31, 1931

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.5 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream.

The point of diversion is located in the NEINEI, Section 16, Township 17 South, Range
22 East, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited toons—fortieth of one cubic foot per second per, acror its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 4 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

7.2 acres in the NE 1NW 1 25.0 acres in the NW 1NW 2 6.8 acros in the SW 1NW 2 1.2 acres in the SE 1NW 1 Section 8 Township 17 South, Range 22 East, W. M.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
