## CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That ROBERT M. STULTS

District Attorney's Office
of Douglas County, Roseburg , State of Oregon , has made proof
to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of

Smith Creek a tributary of Nestucea River

for the purpose of

irrigation
under Permit No. 17170 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters
has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby
confirmed dates from Jamary 14, 1917

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.38 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SELNEL, Section 22, Township & South, Range 10 West, V. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed  $2\frac{1}{2}$  acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

16.0 acres in the SETNET ll.0 acres in the NETSET Section 22
Township 4 South, Range 10 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Beginning at a point at the intersection of E. line of Sec. 22, T. 4 S., R. 10 W., W. M., and W. bank of Nestucca River, thence southerly along W. bank of said River to the county road, said road being on 1/16 line Sec. 22, thence N. 28 chains along road to point, thence E. to Smith Creek, thence southerly along creek to a point due E. of point of beginning, thence E. 14 chains to place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
