This Is to Certify, That J. A. WILLIAMS

.025 cubic foot per second

of Bullards , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Spring Creek a tributary of Coquille River for the purpose of irrigation of cranberries under Permit No. 17598 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 8, 1947

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NE NN Section 20, Township 28 South, Range 14 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to 0.1 of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 0.75 acre foot for each acre irrigated in any 30-day period and shall be still further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 6 acre feet per acre during the irrigation season of each year, and shall be still further limited to a diversion of not to exceed .025 cfs,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

1.1 acres in the NE1NW1 .
Section 20
Township 28 South, Range 11 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Beginning 247.5 ft. south of the NE corner of the NE¹/₂ of Section 20, T. 28 S., R. 14 W., W. M., Coos County, Oregon; thence South 220.0 ft.; West 396.0 ft.; North 220.0 ft.; East 396.0 ft. to beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
