CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That POWELL LANCASTER

of Bridge Route, Myrtle Point , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Middle Fork Coquille River a tributary of Coquille River for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 20916 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from December 19, 1951

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.30 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW1NE1, Section 34, Township 29 South, Range 11 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited toons—eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acror its equivalent for each acro irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 acre feet per acro for each acro irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

17.4 acres in the NV NE 1.8 acres in the SV NE 1.4 acres in the NE NE 1.4 3.0 acres in the SE NE 2. Section 34
