CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That JACOB JOSSI

of Route 1, Box 54, Hillsboro, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream a tributary of McKay Creek for the purpose of irrigation under Permit No. 21611 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from July 15, 1952

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.075 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 17, Township 1 North, Range 2 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

3.7 acres in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
1.4 acres in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$
0.9 acres in the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$

Section 17
Township 1 North, Range 2 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Real estate situate in the County of Washington, State of Oregon, to-wit: Lying and being in Sec. 17, T. 1 N., R. 2 W., W. M., and being also a part of the Joseph L. Meek DLC #61 described as follows: to-wit: Commencing at a point on the E. line of the said Joseph L. Meek DLC in T. 1 N., R. 2 W., said point being S. 36° W. 5.67 chains from the angular corner on the E. line of said Meek DLC, running thence S. 89° 33' W. 17.05 chains, thence S. 10° 58' W. 20.70 chains thence S. 37° 57' W. 7.96 chains to the center of the county road No. A 66, thence S. 46° 11' E. along the center of said county road 5.45 $\frac{1}{2}$ chains, thence S. 61° 15' E. .58 chains to the E. line of said Meek DLC, thence following the E. line of said DLC N. 36° E. 38.28 chains to the place of beginning, containing 30.46 acres, more or less. The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
