CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That GUST PEARSON

of 708 Center Street, Beaverton , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed creek a tributary of Beaverton Creek, a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of

irrigation

under Permit No. 22037 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from January 19, 1953

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.062 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the SE \(\frac{1}{4} \)SW\(\frac{1}{4} \), Section 10, Township 1 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one—eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed $2\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, and shall be still further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 0.062 cfs,

and shall

conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

4.0 acres in the NEA SWA 1.0 acres in the SEA SWA .
Section 10 .
Township 1 South, Range 1 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

(Recorded in Volume 153, page 348 of Washington County, Oregon Deed Records) The W_2^1 of Lot 79 of Steel's Addition to Beaverton, a recorded subdivision in Washington County, Oregon.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
