CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That: GUST JANZEN

of Dayton, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to store the waters of an unnamed stream, tributary of Palmer Creek, to be appropriated under Application No. 24484, Permit No. 20188,

for the purposes of
irrigation

under Reservoir Permit No. R-1123 of the State Engineer, and that said right to store said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from March 8, 1950

that the amount of water entitled to be stored each year under such right, for the purposes aforesaid, shall not exceed 2.5 acre-feet.

The reservoir is located in Section 30 Lot 2 (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ SW $\frac{1}{4}$), Tp. 5 S., R. 3 W., W.M.
