CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That IVERSON LUMBER COMPANY, INC.

of [redacted], Box 1316, Roseburg, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of South Umpqua River a tributary of Pacific Ocean for the purpose of log storage in pond constructed under Appl No. R-27148, Permit No. R-1384 under Permit No. 21521 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 6, 1952

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.20 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 SW 1/4, as projected within Kelly DLC #41, Section 25, Township 27 South, Range 6 West, W. M.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to - - - - - of one cubic foot per second per acre,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:

- NE 1/4 SW 1/4, as projected within Kelly DLC #41
SW 1/4 SW 1/4, as projected within Kelly DLC #41
SE 1/4 SW 1/4, as projected within Kelly DLC #41
Section 25
Township 27 South, Range 6 West, W. M.

Land on which water is to be used is part of that described as follows:

Beginning at the NE corner of Lot 21 "The Oaks on the Southerly R/W line of the Southern Pacific R.R., as platted and filed in the office of the County Clerk of Douglas County. Thence S. 29°12' E. 508.3 ft., along the Ely line of said Lot 21, to a 1/2" iron rod on the Northerly R/W line of the Pacific Hiway. Thence S. 53°48' W., 319.8 ft. along said R/W line to a 3/4" iron bar. Thence N. 26°52' W. 548.6 ft. to a 3/4" iron pipe on the Southerly R/W line of the Southern Pacific R.R. Thence N. 61°00' E. 294.5 ft. along said R/W line to the place of beginning.

The right to the use of the water for the purposes aforesaid is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described.
