CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

of Kernville , State of Oregon , has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of th
Siletz River a tributary of Pacific Ocean for the purpose of
irrigation under Permit No. 11111 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said water has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereb confirmed dates from June 21, 1940
that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purpose aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not excee 0.29 cubic foot per second
or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream The point of diversion is located in the Lot 4 (SW4SW4) Lot 2 (SW4SE4), Section 19, Township 8 South, Range 10 West, W. M.
The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per secon per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2½ acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,
and sha conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer. A description of the place of use under the right hereby confirmed, and to which such right appurtenant, is as follows:
3.6 acres in Lot l. (SW 1SW 1/4) 13.3 acres in Lot 3 (SE 1SW 1/4) 6.0 acres in Lot 2 (SW 1SE 1/4) Section 19 Township 8 South, Range 10 West, W. M.
